The committee will consider many factors in reaching their decision, including the completeness of the application; the applicant's experience and interests; the applicant's personal statement and accomplishments; the applicant's letters of recommendation; and the applicant's degree of scholarship.

ANNOUNCEMENT

The IASP High School Scholarship is for the amount of \$500, paid directly to the bursar at the college the student will be attending. The scholarship recipient will be notified on or before March 30, and will be recognized at the IASP Fall Conference.
